Introduction to FEX

About the course

The Flexible Extract tool (commonly abbreviated and referred to as “FEX”) assists with the task of extracting data from Figaro database files and converting it into a format understandable by personal computers. It can be used for many purposes, from creating Excel-based reports for firms to producing extracts for third parties.

The Introduction to FEX course covers all the knowledge required to create and customise extracts.

Course Objectives

On completing the course, the successful delegate will be able to:

- Use FEX to create extract based on files or SQL queries
- Add headers, footers and other text components to extracts
- Customise extracts using layouts, selection criteria and substitution variables
- Create templates and use them to create extracts

- Users wishing to export Figaro data to third-party applications.
